Eligibility of participants

- 2 representatives(1 scout member and 1 leader) from invited National Scout Organization
- Scout / Venture : Aged 15 to 17
- Leader : Aged 18 to 26





- Qualified scouts as young representatives of your NSO
- Be able to understand and communicate in English
- Be endorsed by his/her NSO
- * An official endorsement letter should be attached with the registration form

Participation Fee

- KSA will cover the inland expense. It includes inland transportation, accomodations, meals and programme.
- Travel cost is not a free but there will be some financial support upon scout category.

*Note

- **Category C, D** : Fund will be reimbursed based on participants flight fare. Participants should submit the invoice and copy of flight ticket during the event.
- **Category A, B** : KSA will offer the proper flight ticket to participant when they finalize the registration and issuing the Visa to Korea(If Visa needed).

Registration

- Please register to send a e-mail(international@scout.or.kr) with **endorsement letter from NSO, registration form and Copy of passport** by 8th December 2017.
- **Participants who needed a visa are required to register by 1st December 2017** to ensure that enough time is available to go through the visa process.
- **Category C, D** : Please do not make travel arrangements before you receive a confirmation letter from the KSA that your registration has been accepted.
- **Category A, B** : KSA will manage the proper travel arrangement after you receive a confirmation letter from the KSA.
